YBSA Monthly Report June 2023

<u>Storage</u>: Total storage in the 5 reservoirs is a 78% capacity. Keechelus will reduce the release of water and Kachess and Cle Elum will increase their release of water to provide a minimum flow in the lower Yakima River. Precipitation for the water year from October to June has been at 74% of average.

<u>Irrigation Water:</u> 2023 water supply is dangerously low. Senior water rights are at 100%, but junior water rights are at 73%. The economy in the Yakima Basin depends on the availability of water annually. See detailed Yakima Herald article by <u>clicking here</u>.

<u>Yakima Basin Integrated Plan:</u> After 15 years the organization has failed to identify additional water for agriculture and instream flow for fish.
